(Hebrews 10:24-25)

READ IT
“And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, 25 not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.”

DISCOVER IT
God never designed the Christian life to be lived alone. In a world that often promotes independence and self-sufficiency, Scripture calls us to something very different – intentional, Christ-centered relationships. Hebrews 10 reminds us that we are to “consider one another,” meaning we should thoughtfully look for ways to build each other up. We are also told to “exhort one another,” which means to come alongside each other with encouragement, truth, and support. So, don’t forsake assembling together with other believers! As followers (disciples) of Jesus Christ, our relationships should help each other grow stronger in faith, love deeper, and live more faithfully – especially as we draw closer to, “the Day” when the Lord returns!

- ASK IT**
- 1_ What do you think it means to “consider one another”? How is that different from just being friendly? Why do you think God emphasizes meeting together regularly?
 - 2_ Can you think of a time when someone encouraged you spiritually? What impact did it have? What are some ways Christians can “exhort one another” this week?
 - 3_ What some dangers that may come from trying to live the Christian life alone?

- LIVE IT**
- 1_ Be intentional, not accidental. Strong relationships don’t just happen. You must choose to invest in others.
 - 2_ Stay connected to God’s people. Regular church involvement isn’t optional; it’s essential for spiritual strength.
 - 3_ Speak life into one another. Use your words to encourage, uplift, and point each other back to Christ.

PRAY IT
Lord, thank You for reminding us that we are not meant to walk this life alone. Help our family to build strong, meaningful relationships that honor You. Teach us to encourage one another, to speak truth in love, and to stay connected to Your people. Protect us from isolation and spiritual drift and help us to grow together in faith as we follow You. May our lives and our relationships point others to You. In Jesus’ name, Amen.

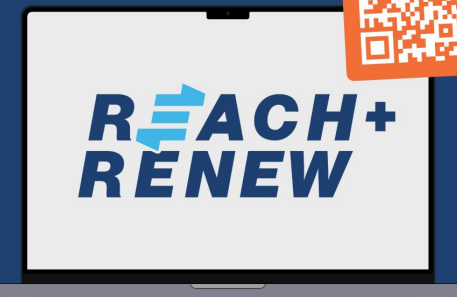

Disaster Relief Training – March 14

If you are a current South Carolina Baptist Convention Disaster Relief volunteer and need to renew your credentials, or if you are looking to become a volunteer in disaster relief, plan now to attend the training on Saturday, March 14 in Spartanburg SC.

This event provides training for those interested in meeting the needs after a natural disaster impacts our city, state or nation. Classes are offered in the various ministry areas of Baptist Disaster Relief: assessment of needs, introduction to chaplaincy, children's response teams, communications, feeding, chainsaw, flood recovery, mud-out, shower/laundry and administration. If you are new volunteer the class, "Introduction to Disaster Relief" is also offered.

If you are interested in going, our South Main Mission Team will help cover the cost of the registration fee (\$45 for returning volunteers and \$55 for new volunteers). Cost includes training materials, lunch and hat/lanyard/shirt and background check for new volunteers. You will register yourself for the training and then notify me (andy.roberson@southmain.church) for financial assistance reimbursement.
