"Give Us This Day Our Daily Bread"  
Matthew 6:11

READ IT  
Please take time to read again the entire Lord's Prayer. (Matthew 6:9-13)

DISCOVER IT  
God is the source of everything we need for life. This simple request is about more than food—it represents all of our physical, material, and daily needs. By asking for "daily" bread, Jesus teaches us to live in moment-by-moment dependence upon God, trusting Him to provide what we need each day rather than worrying about tomorrow. Daily bread living is marked by thankfulness for God's blessings, contentment with His provision, confidence in His faithfulness, and generosity toward others. Ultimately, this petition points us to Jesus Christ, the Bread of Life, who not only meets our earthly needs but satisfies our deepest spiritual need through the gift of salvation.

- ASK IT
1. Have you ever had to pray for literal daily bread? If not, what how should that affect your gratitude today?
  2. Some theologians describe the Christian life as a "hand-to-mouth" existence. What do you think that means? Do you agree or disagree? Why or why not?
  3. Do you find yourself praying more for your needs rather than the needs of others? Read again, Matthew 6:11. Notice the word, "our". Does this indicate that we are to pray for the needs of others.

- LIVE IT OUT NOW
1. From the sermon, daily bread living is marked by: Thankfulness for God's blessings, Contentment for God's provisions, Confidence in God's Care, Generosity toward others and Dependence on Jesus, the Bread of Life. Which of these marks are hard for you at the moment? Pray now asking God to guide you into making your indicated area a spiritual priority of growth in the coming days.
  2. If you are not yet a follower of Christ, please know that Jesus is the Bread of Life. Consider praying now and ask Christ to save you from your sins, death and distance from God. ### Utah Mission Trip Update

Thank you for your prayers and financial support of the Utah Mission Team. Your partnership enabled our team to serve alongside three faithful pastors who are ministering in communities where gospel-centered churches are few and the spiritual need is great.

Our first ministry location was **Hurricane Valley Baptist Church** in Hurricane, Utah, led by Pastor Ben and Michelle Swenson. This congregation of about 60 people sits near the entrance of Zion National Park. From Sunday through Wednesday, our ten-member team partnered with the church to host its annual Vacation Bible School—the largest children's ministry outreach of the year.

Nearly 40 children attended each night. In an area heavily influenced by Mormonism, it was encouraging to see so many families participate. Every child heard the gospel, and approximately six children either trusted Christ or are currently being followed up with because of questions and interest in the gospel message.

On Thursday, we traveled to **Mountain View Baptist Church** in Milford, Utah, where Pastor Shane and Greta Esplin serve. As former Mormons, they are faithfully leading the only evangelical church in the community, a growing congregation of nearly 100 people. Our team helped install a steeple topped with a large cross, creating a visible testimony of Christ in the town. We also completed several maintenance and improvement projects around the church property.

Our final ministry day was spent in **Panguitch, Utah**, near Bryce Canyon National Park, serving with Pastor Jacob Sheifert at Valley Christian Baptist Fellowship. Though the church averages about 45 attendees, it has a meaningful impact in a community where nearly all residents identify as Mormon. We assisted with a one-day VBS that welcomed 13 children. While that number may seem small, it represents a significant outreach opportunity in such a spiritually challenging environment. As in every location, the gospel was shared, children were loved, Scripture was taught, and local church leaders were encouraged.

Thank you again for your faithful support of these ministry partnerships in places where the need for gospel witness remains great. Your prayers and generosity are making a difference.
